- ❑ Turn on two-factor authentication (2FA) [How-To Link](#)
- ❑ Use a strong, unique password - store securely [How-To Link](#)
- ❑ Change password if used on other accounts or if you think you've been hacked [How-To Link](#)
- ❑ Restrict access to only those who need it

Reduce Vulnerabilities

- ❑ **Allow & install automatic LinkedIn app updates**
- ❑ Remove unnecessary or questionable connected apps [How-To-Link](#)
- ❑ Microsoft Word access your profile data [How-To Link](#)
- ❑ Remove unnecessary job application accounts [How-To Link](#)
- ❑ Turn off autoplay for videos [How-To Link](#)
- ❑ Only use LinkedIn on updated devices & web browsers free of malware

Avoid User-Initiated Attacks

- ❑ Don't click links in Messenger until you verify it's legit with sender [Link Checker](#)
- ❑ Don't click links in feed until you verify it's legit (hover over it to get website address) [Link Checker](#)

Detect Threats & Breaches

- ❑ Check logins for suspicious activity and shut down unrecognized logins [How-To Link](#)

Backup Data

- ❑ Download data to a secure device protected with strong, unique password [How-To Link](#)
- ❑ Set a backup email [How-To Link](#)
